Lamb Feedlot Shed Open for Business

One of eastern Australia's biggest lamb feedlot sheds has opened. Based in Goondiwindi, in southern Queensland, it will house more than 3,500 sheep undercover.

Owner, Kerry Corish, says they originally expected to sell around 15,000 fat lambs a year, but that number has significantly increased due to the drought " and because we've bought far more sheep than what we anticipated we would be able to buy, that we probably will go 20,000 plus," Corish said.
